

AGREEMENT FOR ASSIGNMENT OF JUDGMENT

Assignment of Judgment

Expenses

You will not incur or advance any expenses. We will advance all expenses for asset discovery, skip tracing, filing fees, attorney fees, process serving, and related documented expenses incurred in investigating and enforcing the Judgment. If expenses are incurred, we will retain out of any monies we recover, an amount sufficient to satisfy these expenses prior to disbursement of funds to you or us.

Your Payments

After receiving reimbursement for any expenses, as described above, we will pay you, after a period of 90 days from the date of receipt, an amount equal to 50% of any recoveries made in connection with the Judgment, until such time as the Judgment is satisfied or canceled. The funds must be held 90 days to protect you and us from the risk that the Judgment Debtor may declare bankruptcy, and that amounts we recover may be considered a "preference."

Assigning Your Judgment

You affirm that your interest in, and title to, the Judgment is real, marketable, was legally obtained and has not been previously assigned, satisfied, or canceled.

You also affirm that to date you have received no payments with respect to the Judgment except as follows (provide the total amount recovered, if applicable):



Your Collection Efforts

After this Agreement is signed, we will have the exclusive right to enforce and recover the Judgment at our discretion. In addition, we will have complete authority to settle the Judgment for any amount, and on whatever terms we deem reasonable. As a result, from the date of this Agreement, you must (and you should advise all others, including any attorney, to) stop all efforts to enforce the Judgment yourself. Should you receive any payments with respect to this Judgment, you must notify us IMMEDIATELY.

Termination

This Agreement will terminate when the Judgment is satisfied or settled or if Judgment Debtor successfully files an appeal, or requests the Judgment be vacated and that request is granted.

Our Relationship

You understand that, by executing this Agreement, you are assigning the Judgment to us. The Agreement does not create an attorney-client or joint venture relationship. ProJuris is not a law firm, not authorized to render legal advice, and has not and will not provide any legal advice to you in connection with the recovery of the Judgment. We make no guarantees that any funds will be recovered from Judgment Debtor.

Your Authority

By signing this Agreement, you acknowledge that you have read, understand, and fully accepted, the Agreement. If you are a business entity, the person executing below is an authorized representative with the authority to execute this Agreement.
